**ORDER**

WHEREAS, the institution **Ansaldo College of Education, S.F.No. 259/2B & 260/3, Ansaldo Nagar, Keeripillai Odai, Maruthuvampadi Village & Panchayat, Chetpet Post, Polur Taluk, Thiruvannamalai District – 606801, Tamil Nadu** was granted recognition on dated 13.07.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University had forwarded a copy of show cause notice issued to the institution for not functioning in accordance with the conditions stipulated by the NCTE, SRC, Bangalore and Tamilnadu Teachers Education University as could be apprehended from the report of Inspection commission which caused a surprise visit to the colleges.

AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 28.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 01.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> Oct – 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents in response to RPRO issued by the SRC. On perusal of the records, it is found that the institution has not submitted the documents mentioned in RPRO. Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notices to all such institution.

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AND WHEREAS, a First Show Cause Notice was issued on 20.12.2019. The institution has submitted its reply along with relevant documents on 14.01.2020. The above matter was placed before the SRC in its 384<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> February 2020. The Committee considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause to submit the written representation the conditions mentioned therein.

AND WHEREAS, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 05.03.2020. **The institution has not yet submitted any written representation in response to Final Show Cause Notice.** The above matter was placed before the SRC in its 387<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>TH</sup> – 25<sup>TH</sup> August 2020. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under: -

*“The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN) dated 05.03.2020.*

1. *The institution has failed in submission of written representation along with all required documents in response to Final Show Cause Notice.*

*Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition granted to Ansaldo College of Education, Thiruvannamalai District – 606801, Tamil Nadu for conducting B.Ed. course w.e.f. the 2020-21 academic session under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.**”*

AND WHEREAS, a Withdrawal order was issued on 31.08.2020. Now, **the institution vide email dt 09.09.2020 has requested to re-consider the matter as failure in submission of reply was happened due to use the College building as Covid quarantine Centre from 10.04.2020 to 14.08.2020. The orders from the concerned Government is also enclosed. During the said period and up to 14.08.2020 no officer / officials / management representative was allowed to enter.**

AND WHEREAS, the above matter was placed before the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The Committee considered the matter and decided to send a Last Reminder Letter to submit the written representation to the conditions mentioned in final show cause notice dt 05.03.2020. Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 21.09.2020 (P-308/C). The institution has submitted its reply on 23.09.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 389<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

**“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -**

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On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt. 23.09.2020, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **Ansaldo College of Education, Ansaldo Nagar, Keeripillai Odai, Maruthuvampadi, Chetpet Post, Polur Taluk, Thiruvannamalai District – 606801, Tamil Nadu** for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit.”

NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Ansaldo College of Education, S.F.No. 259/2B & 260/3, Ansaldo Nagar, Keeripillai Odai, Maruthuvampadi Village & Panchayat, Chetpet Post, Polur Taluk, Thiruvannamalai District – 606801, Tamil Nadu** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
1. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
  2. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  3. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-


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- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
  - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
  - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
  - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - e. Fee charged from students;
  - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
  - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
  - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
  - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
  - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
4. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
  5. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
  6. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.


